

Marilyn Blazovsky served as the NJ Lottery Acting Executive Director. While at the New Jersey Lottery, she instituted the responsible play program and was the first New Jersey Lottery representative appointed to the Board of Directors for the Council of Compulsive Gambling of New Jersey serving from 1999 to 2004. She was honored by Council with the Hourglass Award in 2004.

As Deputy Director for Operations and Organizational Support at the New Jersey Lottery she directed information services, human resources, winner selection and payment, facilities, and warehouse operations. In other positions she coordinated the legislative and regulatory activities, revamped and expanded the retailer hotline and managed informational exhibits and promotional events. From 2006 through 2010 she served on inter-divisional team which selected a new gaming vendor and implemented the new gaming system for the New Jersey Lottery.

Prior to joining the New Jersey Lottery in 1994, Marilyn was the Manager for Customer Relations and Legislative Affairs for the New Jersey Office of Telecommunications and Information Services and was a member of the management team that started this new statewide office. She also served as the Grants Officer and Policy/Program Development staff advisor at the New Jersey Department of Labor and was a systems analyst for Johnson & Johnson. Marilyn has a wide variety of experience in gaming, responsible play, information services, human resources, federal/state legislative and regulatory process, public relations, management and policy/legislative analysis.

Ms Blazovsky was re-appointed to the Board of Directors for the Council on Compulsive Gambling in 2010 following her retirement from state government and serves as chair of the Human Resources Committee for the Council. Ms. Blazovsky also serves on the Board of Directors for the New Jersey chapter of the Huntington Disease Society of America. She holds a Bachelor's degree from Dunbarton College and a Masters degree in Industrial Relations/Human Resources from Rutgers University.
